Re: KKA Kid's Boom Camp

Reference is made to our end of Term II and beginning of Term III circulars concerning the KKA Kid's Boom camp. The purpose of the Boom camp is to reinforce key skills that will help the children live sensibly and self-reliantly in society. Below are the key points to note;

The camp:

- 1. Shall take place from Tuesday 5th to Saturday 9th December 2023, from 8:00am to 5:00pm every day at school.
- 2. Is organized under the theme: 'Learn a skill today, Create Tomorrow and be Self-reliant for Life', which has been derived from the school year theme: 'Creativity Leads to Excellence'.
- 3. Will involve both KKA and Non-KKA children between 3-12 years of age.
- 4. Will run under two programs namely;
 - a) Day program at UGX: 220,000/=
 - b) Boarding program at UGX: 370,000/=

The Boarding program will not only make it easy for the parents to drop and pick their children daily, but also enhance children's independence and social development through carefully selected activities that are suitable for that time.

Registration is going on at the school front desk and shall be closed on 3rd December 2023.

Below are the identified children's activities for the Boom camp.

- 1. Outdoor games: Football, Netball, Rope skipping, Dodgeball, Swinging and sliding, Swimming, Aerobics etc
- 2. Indoor Games: Ludo, Chess, Playing cards, Snakes and ladders etc
- 3. Self Help Skills: Bathing, brushing teeth, dressing up, using the toilet, combing, smearing, laying the bed, washing utensils, washing clothes, cutting nails, e.t.c
- 4. Survival Skills: Reading, writing, computer literacy, cookery and bakery, making crafts like baskets, mats, hair dressing, gardening, etc
- 5. Social Etiquette, Moral and Religious values: Magic words, eating habbits, bible reading / Quran recitation, memorizing Bible/ Quran verses, Bible/ Quran stories, Counselling and Guidance, Biblical / Quran drama, Praise, worship and prayer, Bible / Quran Quiz, Preaching, Dua and hadith for Muslims
- 6. Cultural Games/Songs: Omweso, Sonko, Seven stones, traditional songs, games of low organisation etc.
- 7. Others; Campfire, goat roasting, songs, understanding my gender, safety and security, Self-defense, First aid, IT and Digital discipline, Gymnastics, financial discipline for children (saving culture).

All the above activities shall be categorized basing on the children's age groups and conducted by both Internal and External facilitators. All participants shall get a certificate of attendance and an event Souvenir T-shirt.

- 2. The first 30 children to register will get a discount of UGX 20,000/=.
