Re: End of Term II 2026 Parents' Circular

Greetings from the Management, Staff and Children of Kampala Kindergarten Association (KKA). We thank the Almighty God for enabling us to successfully complete term II today, Wednesday 19th August, 2026. We congratulate and thank you dear parents for your continued support in all the school programmes. As we break off for the holidays, we wish to communicate the following to you:

I. END OF TERM II 2026

a. Children's Progress Reports

Every child has been given an End of term II Progress Report. Please study your child's report carefully and if there are any issues of concern, kindly approach the Class Teacher or Head Teacher for clarity. In case the teacher has indicated or recommended something in the child's report, we request you to address it for the good of the child.

b. Holiday Motivation Work

All children have been given Holiday motivation work to help them revise the taught concepts. Please, encourage your child to do the work under the supervision of a responsible person and return it at the beginning of term III 2026 for marking. The Holiday Motivation work includes a project work section which the child has to read carefully and embark on at the beginning of the holiday in order to complete it in time. The parents' encouragement and guidance is very vital in this aspect.

c. Children's Files

Your child's paper-work has been filed in his/her file. You are advised to help your child revise the taught concepts and do corrections using the filed papers. We request the Parents to empty the file and return it to school at the beginning of Term III 2026.

2. TERM III ACTIVITIES

a. Class photos

The school took Class photos from 15th to 19th June, 2026. Every child was expected to take a copy for home records at a cost of **Ugx 2500/=** only. Those of you who have not yet picked their copies from the teachers, are requested to do so at the beginning of Term III, 2026.

b. Study Trips

As a way of exposing children to a wider environment, the school organized Education trips for all the children from 22nd to 26th June, 2026. While the Nursery section and Primary Two visited the Uganda Wildlife Education Centre – Entebbe, the Primary One children visited Wavamunno Mixed Farm -Nakwero. We thank the parents for the contribution of **Ugx 20,000/=** towards entry.

In addition to the general trips, classes conducted trips to different places as part of this term's Literacy project. By the time the Government issued a directive to stop school trips, most of our study trips had been completed. We also thank the parents who signed and returned the consent forms in time and continue to urge others to always respond in a timely manner whenever such forms are given to you, to allow the smooth running of the school activities.

c. Open week

The school organized an Open week from Monday 13th to Friday 17th July, 2026 with the purpose of giving parents an opportunity of checking and discussing their children's progress. Parents who did not turn up are advised not to miss this important teacher-parent interaction next time.

d. Term II Literacy Project

The Term II Literacy project culminated in an exhibition which was held on Saturday August 8, 2026 under the theme "**Persistent Practice makes an Excellent Reader and Writer**" which was extracted from the year theme; "**Persistence leads to Excellence**". We recognize the special participatory role of the parents who read stories to the different classes and the Guest of Honour **Dr. Safina Mutumba** from the Ministry of Education and Sports, for accepting to preside over the function despite her busy schedule.

I would like to recognize the classes that emerged the winners of the Literacy Exhibition; Class 5B at the Blue level and overall winner, Class 4B at the Green Level, class 1A at the Red level and Primary Two at the Primary level. We thank the teachers, children and support staff for their tireless and selfless effort towards the success of the event. A victory party was organized for the winners and the rest of the children celebrated with them, as you know at KKA everyone is a winner.

Children's Literacy story books

We wish to send our sincere appreciation to all parents for the contribution towards the publishing of the Children's Literacy Story Books. Each parent who contributed received a book through his/her child. Children's Health

We have experienced mild cough, colds and high temperatures leading to irregularity at school for a few children. We thank the parents who have been co-operative whenever called upon to pick their sick children for further treatment.

Primary Level Examinations:

While the Day Care and Nursery sections children at KKA are not subjected to examinations, the Primary children sat for internal and external examinations at the beginning, in the middle and at the end of the term. The children performed well.

3. GENERAL ISSUES

a. KKA Platinum Jubilee Celebrations:

We wish to inform you that the KKA Community shall have the climax of the Platinum Jubilee Celebrations next term. More details will be communicated in the due course.

However, please take note of the following;

b. School Fees

The school dues have remained the same; Tot's Palace 1,300,000/ per term, Primary level - Normal Programme (half day) 1,112,000/=, Day Care Programme (full day) 1,392,000/=, Nursery section - Normal Programme (half day) 1,112,500/=, Day Care Programme (full day) 1,392,500/= All school dues are paid in the bank before the beginning of the term. No child will be allowed in the classroom before full payment of fees is made. Please be informed that you can only pay cash for the following: late pick-up, clubs, lunch, extra uniforms, lost/spoilt library books and diaries, for which you have to get a receipt. Post-dated cheques are not accepted by the school any more.

c. School Transport Scheme

Parents with children on the Transport scheme are requested to pay the term's charges before the service is delivered. There are 55 school days in term III 2026. The money has been calculated and indicated on the bank slip. Please note the following changes in the charges: Pick & drop short (UGX 15,000/-), Pick & drop long (UGX 17,000/-), Pick or drop short (UGX 9,500/-), Pick or drop long (UGX 10,500/-)

d. Admissions for 2026 & 2027

We wish to inform you and the general public that we are still enrolling children for the academic year 2026 in all classes and application for the academic year 2027 is now open. Interested parents are encouraged to pick, fill and return the application forms before the end of September 2026.

N.B We wish to thank the parents who have entrusted us with their children at the Primary level and gladly inform you that we have continued to expand up to Primary three for the academic year 2027. We encourage the parents of the Blue level to apply for our Primary one intake for 2027 and request you to inform relatives and friends who have children of Day care, Nursery, Primary one, two and three on our behalf.

e. Amazon Club:

As usual, the club will be operating during the holidays from Monday to Friday starting on Monday August 24, 2026 from 9:00am to 5:00pm, for all levels (Primary, Yellow, Red, Green, Blue and the Alumni/siblings who are below 12 years of age). The club has two programmes namely:

1. Half day (9:00am -12:30pm) at Ugx: 120,000/= (includes a break meal but no lunch).
2. Full day (9:00am — 4:00pm) at Ugx: 180,000/= (includes break and lunch meals).
