We officially opened the school for Term III on Wednesday September 16, 2026 and we have already embarked on our programme as follows:

a) Thanksgiving and Dedication service for 75 years of excellence.

The school is organizing a Thanksgiving and Dedication service in commemoration of KKA at 75 years of existence on **Fri. Sept. 25th, 2026** starting at **9:00am**. The children and staff will have the service from school to celebrate the long life, achievements and excellence of KKA as we dedicate it to the almighty God. b) Open Week:

This term's Open week shall take place from **Mon. 26th - Fri. 30th Oct. 2026** and it is mainly organized for promotion purposes. Depending on the child's progress, both the class teacher and the parent will agree on the child's appropriate class of promotion.

c) Admissions for 2026 & 2027

We wish to inform you and the general public that we are still enrolling children for the academic year 2026 in all Kindergarten classes. Parents who wish to enroll their children for the academic year 2027 should pick, fill and return the application forms before October 16, 2026.

N.B: We wish to thank the parents who have entrusted us with their children in the Primary section and gladly inform you that we have continued to expand our Primary section up to Primary three for the academic year 2027. We encourage the parents of the Blue level to apply for the Primary one intake, 2027 and request you to inform relatives and friends who have children of Day care, Nursery, Primary one - three on our behalf.

d) Interviews (Entry assessment) for 2027 Entrants:

The school will hold interviews for 2027 entrants for the Kindergarten level, Primary one - three on **Saturday October 31, 2026** at the school after the cleaning exercise. Please take note that the school will only be able to contact parents who will have returned the filled application forms for the interviews.

e) KKA Platinum Jubilee Celebrations and End of year Concert:

We wish to inform you that the KKA Community shall have the climax of the Platinum Jubilee Celebrations and End of year concert on Saturday November 21, 2026. More details will be communicated in the due course. Please take note of the following;

i) The Platinum Shop:

h) KKA Kids Boom camp

KKA initiated a skilling program for the children which is popularly known as '**KKA Kids Boom Camp**' for both KKA and non KKA children between 3-12 years. It takes place during the December holidays. The camp has a day program at Ugx: **220,000/=** and a boarding program at Ugx: **370,000/=**. This year's Boom Camp shall take place from 8th – 12th Dec. 2026. Please register your child by making payment to the school Bursar before **15th November 2026** for proper planning. The first 20 children to get registered shall be given a discount.

Kindly also take note of the following:

a) Children's Literacy story books

For security purposes, we do not permit a person who has not been formally introduced to the school to pick up a child. We therefore remind every parent to pick up his/her child's personal secret number for use in case of an emergency that may require sending someone else.

e) Sick Children:

In order to control the spread of infectious diseases among the children, you are reminded to leave the sick children at home. **Please note:** The school gives First Aid where need be and isolates the sick child until he/ she is picked by the parent to go for medical check-up and further management. We also remind you that the school does not allow children to come with medicine. In case of any special treatment to the child, the parent should seek approval from the Head teacher.
